

ARTICLE XIV.

Corresponding and Honorary members shall be entitled to attend the meetings and to take part therein, but without the right of voting on any motion or proposition.

ARTICLE XV.

*Patrons.*

His Excellency the Governor General of Canada, and Their Honors the Lieutenant Governors of the Provinces of the Dominion, are solicited to become Patrons of this Society.

ARTICLE XVI.

The officers of the Society shall be :

A President ;

Three Vice-presidents ;

Two Corresponding Secretaries : one for the French correspondence and the other for the English correspondence ;

Two Assistant-secretaries ;

A Recording-secretary ;

An Assistant Recording-secretary ;

A Librarian ;

A Treasurer.

ARTICLE XVII.

*Council.*

The Council shall be composed of all the officers of the Society and of five councillors elected at the time and in the manner hereinafter provided by Article XIX of the constitution. The Council shall be charged with the management of all matters of detail of the Society. Five members of the Council, one of whom shall be the President or one of the
