



Fall Work in a Northern Ontario Plum Orchard

The illustration shows Mr. W. J. Justice, of Barrie, harvesting his plum crop. There are about two and one-half acres devoted to this fruit crop and this year the return is about 1000 baskets. They include such valuable varieties as Lombard, Green Gage, Imperial Gage, Yellow Gage, Reine Claude, Pond's Seedling, Mr. Smith, Roman and Burbank. The trees are set 20 feet apart each way. Immediately under them is a row of gooseberries on each side, and between these two rows are rows of currants. The man standing to the left is Mr. Justice.
