The scene of the story is fixed in Canada, and its central figure is a young man, who, being placed in the penitentiary on circumstantial evidence, there learns to understand the spirit of Christ's self-giving, and is finally set free through the instrumentality of a Christian doctor, whose whole life has been a career of love and of active service in behalf of others. The author of this work is a native Canadian resident of Canada and portrays the scenes and incidents of the story with fidelity and in a vividly interesting manner.
