2. Whether tenders were called for this work. If not, why.

3. The overseer of this work, and whether he had any experience in such work previous to this appointment.

4. How much was expended, (a) in material; (b) in labour.

5. Whether the material was secured in the parish or county. If not, why.

6. Whether the material was purchased by contract. If not, why.

7. If by contract, who supplied the material and at what price.

1. What dividends have been declared by the Trust and Loan Companies making returns to the Government during the years 1930, 1931, 1932, and 1933.
