violate conflict of interest guidelines and to deceive this House at any time, and any self-respecting Minister would resign.

Some Hon. Members: Hear, hear!

Mr. Andre: That is the tragedy of this country, Mr. Speaker, that flim-flam passes for policy.

Mr. Fisher: Nonsense. Come on!

Mr. Andre: It is a tragedy that solemn commitments of this Government as to their policy can be violated like that, without any consideration, because they know they can count on a silent, obedient, non-thinking backbench, who will say, "Aye, sir, Aye" to the most outrageous behaviour because they are not going to jeopardize their opportunity to get appointed as Chairman of Air Canada or Chairman of the CNR or to be appointed to the Senate. They are not going to jeopardize that possibility by thinking, by being concerned about Canada, by suggesting that Ministers should be honest and should obey guidelines and should not leak budgets, and if they do, however accidentally, they must take the consequences of their action. Never would one of those Hon. Members be expected to require that standard of behaviour. Not on your nellie. Oh, no, no, no! Let us get our priorities straight. Looking after Liberals is what this place is all about. Canada comes second, and a damned poor second.

We know, Mr. Speaker, that the Estimates tabled by the President of the Treasury Board just two months ago were flim-flam. They were inaccurate. They were wrong.
