They are not going to jeopardize that possibility by thinking, by being concerned about Canada, by suggesting that Ministers should be honest and should obey guidelines and should not leak budgets, and if they do, however accidentally, they must take the consequences of their action. Never would one of those Hon. Members be expected to require that standard of behaviour. Not on your nellie. Oh, no, no, no! Let us get our priorities straight. Looking after Liberals is what this place is all about. Canada comes second, and a damned poor second.

We know, Mr. Speaker, that the Estimates tabled by the President of the Treasury Board just two months ago were flim-flam. They were inaccurate. They were wrong.
