The "VITTORIC VENETO" Lodge No. 1248 of 12 The ORDER SONS OF ITALY in CANADA, in-22 formed by some of its members that on on Sunday, March 21st, a small number of 贊 men, who overtly call themselves Italian 19 Communists, participated in a pubblic 17 meeting held at the Monument National, 17 and, declaring to represent the Italians 12 of Montreal, made vulgar and untrue sta-tements concerning the King of Italy, 22 the Italian Government and the General 12 Sir W. Currie, Commander in Chief of the 件 Canadian Corps during the Great War; having also noticed and fully conside-11 red a report of said pubblic meeting as it appears on the Montreal "Daily 22 Star" of Monday 22nd inst.; and -WHEREAS it is the unanimous opinion 22 of the Lodge that participation of Ita-12 lians or Canadians of Italian origin 22 at the said meeting constitutes an of-12 fence against the Motherland as well as 12 an offence against our adopted country, the Dominion of Canada, and WHEREAS there 12 is not in Montreal any other Body Corporate and politic so truly representative 22 as the ORDER OF THE SONS OF ITALY which -22 may sustain and defendthe good name and 11 honor of the Italians residing here and 22 WHEREAS the actions of unresponsible few 12 shall not influence public opinion aga-= inst the Italians :

BE IT UNANIMOUSLY RESOLVED : That a request be immediately made in the name of this Lodge to the GRAND EXECUTIVE COUNCIL of the 12 17 GRAND LODGE OF THE ORDER OF THE SONS OF ITALY for a Resolution in 12 the name of the Order as representing the whole Italian Community 18 condemning as this Lodge from now unanimously condemns the person or persons that on Sunday March 21st made any vulgar or injurious 22 statements against the King of Italy and its Government and also 教 against General Sir W. Currie, O.C. in C. of the Canadian Corps in the -Great War; BE IT FURTHER RESOLED that a copy of such resolution be forwardedi to the Consul General of Italy in Montreal with the 22 expression of a deep feeling of indignation of all the members of 28 our Community; BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a letter embodying
