
THE ROTOGRAPH SERVICE

College, University and Public Libraries are asked to send to the Treasurer of the Modern Language Association twenty-five dollars a year for the purpose of promoting rotographic reproductions of manuscripts and rare printed books in their libraries. The rotographs are deposited in the Division of Manuscripts of the Library of Congress, which prints and catologues them without cost to the Association. Contributing institutions have their names upon the material collected, but reproductions are being made by rights connected with contributing institutions are at the service of other institutions and of individual individuals under regulations formulated by the officials of the Library of Congress and the Committee of the Modern Language Association.

Rotographs are sent to those who desire them by mail in accordance with the mailing system of their library. Large orders should be addressed by requesting the loan in the Division of Manuscripts, Library of Congress, and should specify that the reproduction is desired for the use of a professor or other well known scholar whose name is given, or for student working under the direction of a teacher.
