M.A. candidates, due principally to the French School, is increasing rapidly, the work is assuming such proportions that it is next to impossible to handle it all. For instance, no less than ten theses will have to be read next September, by the Department, in fact, by the Head of the Department, since he will be the only member available at that time.

The remedy for the lack of Staff is obvious.
