It comprises explanatory remarks and comments on the Code of Civil Procedure, and of its Statutory Amendments, a study of the organisation of the Civil Court of this province and the history of the different judicial systems of the country, also the special modes of procedure provided by the Statutes and the by-laws in general, as well as the Bar Act, and the by-laws regarding the discipline of the Bar.	CIVIL PROCEDURE..... 130 This course must extend over a period of at least two years. It shall comprise explanatory remarks with comments on the Code of Civil Procedure and on the statutory amendments, modifying and completing it, a study of the organisation and jurisdiction of the civil courts of this province, including the Supreme Court of Canada, the Court of the Exchequer, also the special modes of procedure provided by the statutes or by the laws of general application. THE BAR ACT.....10 This course shall comprise an inquiry into the Bar Act and the by-laws of the Bar with explanatory remarks respecting the dignity and responsibility of the attorney.
