

14. The Commander in Chief may, from time to time, order any persons who have obtained final certificates in any School of Military Instruction and whether the same be Commissioned Officers or not, to attend a Camp or Camps of Instruction at such time and place in this Province and for such period as he may for such purpose prescribe, and he may make all necessary rules and regulations for the command, and discipline and good management of such Camp or Camps and for the mode of instruction thereat and shall prescribe the allowances to be paid to such persons during their stay at the same; and every person who shall report himself at such Camp or Camps and shall sign a Roll of Entry thereat shall thereupon and thenceforth and for the period prescribed by the Commander in Chief for the duration of such Camp or Camps, be subject to the Queen's Rules and Regulations, the Mutiny Act and the Rules and articles of war, and to such other Orders, Rules and Regulations, of whatever nature or kind to which Her Majesty's troops are subject.

Persons having obtained final certificates of Military Instruction may be called on to attend camps of instruction.
