SIR LOMER GOUIN ON THE LANGUAGE QUESTION.

(From the great speech on Quebec and Confederation, delivered by SIR LOMER GOUIN. Prime Minister of Quebec in the Quebec Legislative Assembly, January 23rd, 1918.)

"Questions of language, Mr. Speaker, have existed since the world was a world. They existed even previous to the Tower of Babel. Almost everywhere they have resulted in division and in regrettable struggles which always ended with a settlement and this, I am convinced, will also be the case in Ontario.
