

4. Total Conscription is an outgrowth of Technocracy and has been in our literature for nearly two years, but it is not to be confused with the social programme of Technocracy. In making this demand for total conscription, Technocracy is not calling for the installation of Technocracy's social programme. This distinction must be clearly made. Total conscription is a victory programme for installation by the government of the United States under the war-time authority of the constitutional Commander in Chief of the nation. It does not call for the installation of Technocracy or for the placing of this organization in any position of authority. It is impossible for anyone to accuse Technocracy of having political ambitions, or attempting to foist itself upon the nation under the guise of a war-time emergency.
