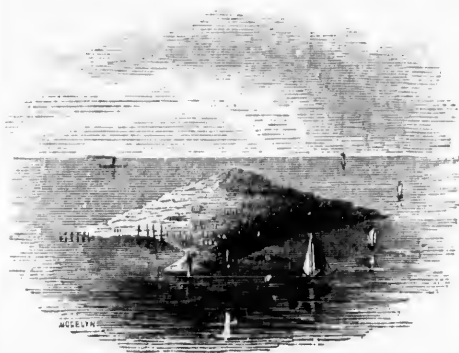

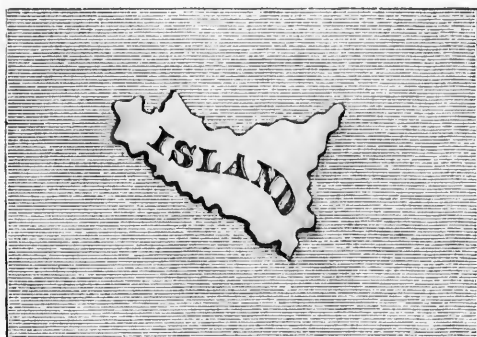

Here is a Picture of some land surrounded by water. It is called an Island.

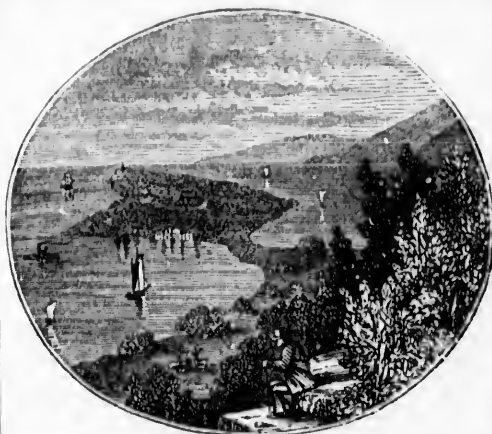
What is an Island?

An Island is land surrounded by water.



Here is a Map of an Island.

By what is an Island surrounded?
By Water.



Here is a Picture of a portion of land something like an Island, only it is not quite surrounded by water. It is called a Peninsula.

What is a Peninsula?

A Peninsula is land not quite surrounded by water.

What is an Isthmus?

An Isthmus is land which joins a Peninsula to the main land.
