REPORT ON LIABILITY OF SHIPOWNERS UNDER

BILLS OF LADING

Ottawa, March 16—(Canadian Press)
The Imperial shipping commission ap-
pointed last June by the British Govern-
ment, after consultation with the govern-
ments of Canada, Australia, New Zea-
land and South Africa, has submitted a
report on the limitation of shipowners
liability under bills of lading. It unani-
mously recommends uniform legislation
throughout the empire on lines of ex-
isting acts but based more precisely on
the Canadian water carriage goods act
1910, subject to provisions in regard to
exceptional cases in which goods may be
carried at owner's risk, precise defini-
tion of psychical limits to shipowners'
liability of fixing of monetary limits of
liability.

It is considered improbable that any
legislation along the lines suggested will
be enacted by the governments interested
during the present year.

these 945 persons were killed and 22,781
injured, according to reports of city
police departments.
