REPORT ON LIABILITY OF
SHIPOWNERS UNDER
BILLS OF LADING
Ottawa, March 16—(Canadian Press)
—The imperial shipping committee appointed last June by the British Government, after consultation with the governments of Canada, Australia, New Zealand and South Africa, has submitted a report on the limitation of shipowners liability under bills of lading. It unanimously recommends uniform legislation throughout the empire on lines of exexisting acts but based more precisely on the Canadian water earriage goods act 1910, subject to provisions in regard to exceptional cases in which goods may be carried at owner's risk, precise definition of pyschical limits to shipowent's liability of fixing of monetary limits of liability.

It is considered improbable that any legislation along the lines suggested will be enacted by the governments interested during the present year.
