

# IMPOSSIBLE IF YOU HAVE DANDRUFF

To 8 well-beaten eggs add 1 cup of fine sugar (granulated). Beat well, add 1 cup of flour with 1 teaspoon of cream of tartar, well sifted, with it. Add 1-2 teaspoon soda, dissolved in a very little milk, a little salt and teaspoon extract of lemon. Spread thin on long shallow pan, bake until just done and no more. Have ready a clean towel, jelly and silver knife. Turn cake upside down on towel, quickly spread with jelly and roll up. Don't let it get cool. Wrap in clean napkin a little while and keep in shape. Have your dough about 1-4 inch in pan before baking.
