Advices from England show that the sale of Ontario fattened poultry sent from St. John to Liverpool about a month ago was most successful: The birds met a ready sale in 'Liverpool at 16 cents per pound, wholesale. The chickens were sent plucked, but not drawn, and weighed an average of 5 1-2 pounds each. The wholesale price was equal to \$1.76 per pair, a profit of 70 cents per pair.

The Chicago Record says: Count de Jotemps, of Paris, France, has closed a contract for the purchase of about \$5.00,000 worth of motor vehicles of Chicago manufacture. The Count is president of the American Motor Agency, with headquarters at Paris and offices in every capital in Europe. The aim of this company, it is said, is to control the European agency for the sale of American manufactured vehicles.
