

shall be deemed to be, executed by this Grand Lodge on being signed by the Grand Chief Templar, Grand Secretary and Grand Treasurer for the time being, and sealed with the seal of this Grand Lodge.

*Sec 5.*—That in case a District or Subordinate Lodge shall become defunct, or surrender its charter, all properties, real or personal, of said Lodge, shall revert to this Grand Lodge.

LECTURES.

*Article 24.*—When our Grand Lodge employs a Grand Lodge lecturer, said lecturer shall have taken the Juvenile pledge and still maintains the same.

DISCUSSIONS ON DANCING.

*Article 25.*—The discussion of any phase of the dancing question at any regular or special meeting of any subordinate Lodge in this jurisdiction is strictly prohibited, and any wilful violation of this section will work a suspension of the charter of said Lodge.

*Article 26.*—Non-representatives taking the Grand Lodge Degree shall be charged a fee of one dollar.

CODE OF APPEALS.

*Article 27.*—No part of these By-Laws shall be repealed, annulled or altered, except where express provision is made in certain Articles for their change, unless a proposition to that effect be presented to the Grand Lodge in writing, signed by at least five regular representatives or past representatives. Said proposal shall be referred to the Committee on Constitution and By-Laws without debate. A two-thirds vote of all members present shall be required to adopt a report recommending an amendment.
