

Months next after the return of the Master to the Port or Place from which he sailed on such voyage.

5 And be it further Enacted, That nothing in this Act contained shall extend, or be construed to extend, to Ships carrying Passengers in cases in which the number of such Passengers shall not exceed *One* Passenger for every Five tons of the registered burthen of such Ship, nor to any Ship in the service of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Admiralty, or in the service of His Majesty's Postmaster-General.

Exception of particular kinds of Ships.

10 And be it further Enacted and Declared, That the Bahama Islands and the Bermuda Islands, and His Majesty's Possessions in the West Indies, are not and shall not be deemed and taken to be comprised within the conditions aforesaid, or any of them.
