B. in Dorchester, N.B., 1 May, 1846. Ed. at St. Joseph's College, Memramcook. Called to the Bar, N.B., 1870. M., Sept., 1872, Bridget, youngest dau. of Mr. Timothy McCarthy, of Fredericton. First returned to Parlt. for present seat at last g.e. A Liberal.—*Dorches-*

DSAY, Hon. WILLIAM. [*Carleton.*]

B. in Irel. A merchant. Has been a mem. of the County Council of Carleton. Was a mem. of the Ex. Council, without office, from 1868, Surveyor-Genl., from Oct., 1870, to Feb., 1871, when he retired with the other members of the Ex. Council. Has sat for present seat since 1862. A Liberal.—*Woodstock.*
