BILL.

An Act to authorize the Courts of Common Law, and Equity in Upper Canada, in their discretion, to admit Henry John Greenstreet to practice as an Attorney and Solicitor therein.

HEREAS Henry John Greenstreet of West Flam-Preamble. West Flam-Preamble borough, in the County of Halton, Gentleman, hath by his Petition truly set forth that he hath been duly admitted and practiced for some years as an Attorney and Solicitor in the Courts of Common Law and Equity, at Westminster, and hath prayed that the Courts of Common Law and Equity in Upper Canada may be authorized, in their discretion, to admit him to practice the Law as an Attorney and Solicitor; and it is expedient to grant the prayer of his petition: Be it therefore enacted, &c.

That it shall and may be lawful for the Courts of Queen's Courts of Law Bench and of Common Pleas for Upper Canada, in their and Equity in discretion, to admit the said Henry John Greenstreet as rized to admit an Attorney of the said Courts respectively; and for the H. J. Greenstreet of Chancery for Upper Canada, in its discretion, to tice therein admit him to practice as a Solicitor in the said Court, any law or usage to the contrary notwithstanding.
