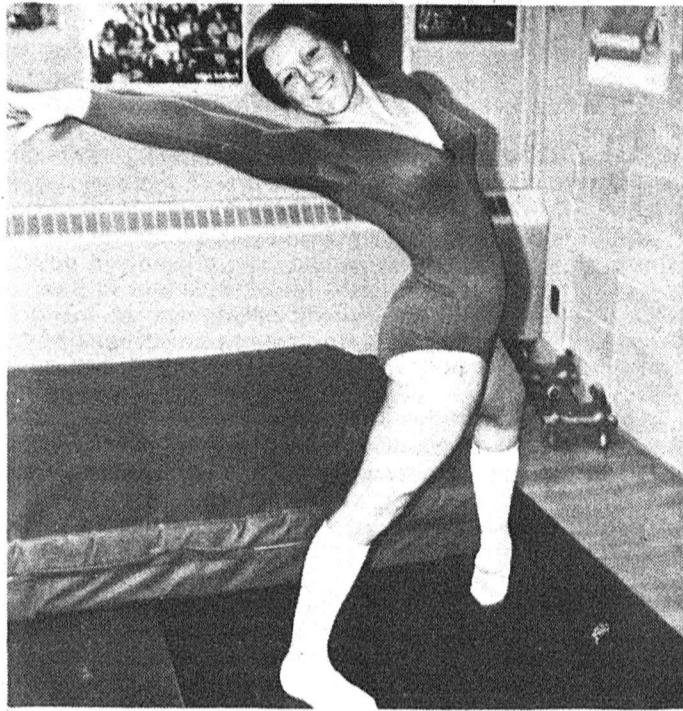

# Pandas lead west



Panda power... Jayne Welch helped lead the CWUAA to another national title.

Pandas gymnasts Peggy Mackay and Jayne Welch provided the main support for winning the 1977 C.W.I.A.U. National championships March 5, 6, 7 in Fredericton. It is the second year the Canada West Conference has taken the win. Jennifer Paterson, past Olympian representing UBC, captured the top spot around with Downton and Wah-King Ng taking 2nd and 5th around positions.

Peggy's Pink Panther exercise gave her a silver medal and Wah-King's bars and beam routines captured bronze medals. Both girls were finalists in three of the four events. The standings were:

- Canada West 158
- Ontario 155
- Great Plains 124
- Atlantic 112

In the men's standings, Gordon Osborne was the Golden Bear qualified to attend Nationals this year. Osborne placed a respectable 12th around out of 35 competitors without his team to back him. His judging seemed severe. Ontario Conference won with 248.05 with Atlantic second (211.85) and Canada West third (210.30). Mark Epprecht, Bob Carisse and Dave Steeper, all York University took the top three all around standings.

McMaster University now has a third option for students interested in proceeding to a Master of Business Administration degree: a co-operative option, whereby students alternate four-month periods of study and relevant work experience. A limited number of applications will be accepted for the semester beginning in September, 1977.

**Co-op**
