Dear Editor:

In response to last week's 'Editorial' and 'Sound Off' columns in the Brunswickan, we would like to collectively clear up some of the misinformation that was suggested and also provide some facts that were conveniently left out.

Without doubt, from year to year, there are going to be organizations and individuals who will be dissatisfied with Administrative Board decisions, but we are certain that there are just as many who leave quite content in the knowledge that they have presented themselves, and the organizations that they represent, well. Not ironically, it is most often the groups who arrive at A.B. meeting with inflated budgets beyond belief or justification who go away muttering under their breath.

Despite what was written last week, the Brunswickan and CHSR have never been used as excuses for cutting back budgets of other organizations. However, when the question was asked as to where each individual student's dollars are going, it was explained that "so much goes to S.U.B. mortgage, so much to the Brunswickan, so much to CHSR, etc." When the discussion turned to where last year's surplus was directed, the

answer came back "CHSR" because that is exactly where it is going. It became apparent that most organizations were under the impression that each had a share in the surplus, and were quickly informed otherwise.

To counter the accusations that media expenditures are being cut back, how can you explain to the readers, as Editor of the Brunswickan, that you conveniently misplaced the minimum \$32,000 figure that is to be spent on CHSR-FM capital expenditures this coming year? Rather than cutting back on the media, is the Student Union not increasing the allocated funds to the media two-fold? Particularly, in the case of the Brunswickan, last year the net expenditures incurred were some \$15,293 yet the Brunswickan budget this year boasts a \$21,000 figure. If we are to be criticized, it would appear that the criticism lies in allocating too much money to the media. However, we know that advertising revenue cannot be guaranteed and thus the high figure. The argument to be made is that anyone can make a point by manipulating figures, as was shown last week.

Comments made as to the content of the Administrative

Board were also made without much forethought. A closer look at the members will show that indeed there is much variety and experience embedded within the Board. One point to note is that the Administrative Board is open to any full-time U.N.B. student and openings have been advertised occasionally in the Brunswickan in the past two months. If students who, as you depict, (sic) really represent the students (ie: media, Board of Governors, etc.) had applied to the Board they would have been welcomed. However, no such applications were received.

In conclusion, we stress that as the Administrative Board, we are but an arm of the Student Union and are but the initial contact in the budgeting process. If any organization feels that they are handled in an unfair manner or are justified in asking for additional funds, there exists an appeal procedure, that being the S.R.C. If cutbacks are necessary for some organizations, it is because of declining enrollment. The S.R.C. is going to cutback their budget this year, as promised.
