TO

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR GENERAL IN COUNCIL:

The Convention concluded between Canada and the United States at Washington on the 2nd March, 1923, to secure the preservation of the Halibut Fishery of the Northern Pacific Ocean, having now been approved by the United States Senate without reservation, the undersigned recommends that Your Excellency address a telegraphic despatch to the Secretary of State for the Colonies asking that His Majesty be humbly moved to ratify the said Convention, and that the instrument of ratification be forwarded to Your Excellency to be exchanged in Washington by the representative of the Canadian Government against the similar ratification of the President of the United States.
