

to Spain, which would facilitate her continued participation in the work of the League, H.M. Government will examine them sympathetically and with real desire to find them acceptable."

A similar communication has been made to the Spanish Government.

It appears from information received from H.M. Ambassador at Paris and Rome that neither the French nor Italians are favourably disposed to this solution. In any case, it seems to be a complicated question which could hardly be brought to a satisfactory conclusion in the limited time remaining before the next meeting of the Council.
