

'This foreign company and every other foreign company will be required, if the bill is enacted into law, to pay its fair proportion of premium taxes into the treasury of each state in which it supplies indemnifying bonds to National banking associations

'The sole purpose of the legislation is to eliminate the notoriously unfair advantage which the foreign company in question has long enjoyed and still enjoys over the American companies, and to require it to bear its equitable share of the burdens which are now being borne exclusively by the American companies and from which the latter have no means of escape.'
