Dear Mr.Meighen:

My thought in phoning your office the other day was to suggest an interview in which I could review the recent developments regarding the use of power for the production of hydrogen and oxygen.

This subject is now being actively developed by important German interests who have established contacts with several power companies in Canada. Their statements of the possibilities make anything I have said seem quite modest.

I have some new suggestions, particularly regarding the storage of energy, which have interested Dr.Gaby and engineers of the Hydro. These are now being studied by committees of Hydro engineers and I feel that we can accomplish in an improved manner most of the effects claimed by the Germans.

I think that you would be interested in having me review these matters at your convenience.
