Under authority of Order in Council P.C. 11/365 of the 13th February, 1936, the allowances for the Indian Agent at Williams Lake were valued as follows:

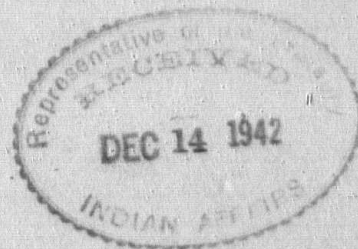
