

- (d) THAT in the event of the surrender being accepted that Mr. MacKay request Dr. Bruner or his solicitors to have a British Columbia Land Surveyor at the Doctor's expense make a division of the reserve so as to give the Indians 75 acres of cultivated land, in addition to the bush and <sup>excluding</sup> the land occupied by the dyke in the eastern half.
- (e) THAT in the event of Dr. Bruner objecting to these conditions and terms, Mr. MacKay make such temporary arrangements as will not delay the parties affected in cropping the land on the reserve this spring.
- (f) THAT title when issued, preferably in the form of a lease, be conditional, so that the land will revert to the Indians if the reclamation project should fail, be abandoned, or not properly cared for.
