

WATER AND WATERCOURSES—*continued.**defences:*

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- defence to an action for disturbance of water rights denying plaintiff's possession of the land, &c., 943.
- defence to a like action by a reversioner denying the reversion, 945.
- denial of the right to the watercourse, &c., 945.
- defence of a right under the Prescription Act, 1832, to use the water for agricultural purposes, 945.
- the like to use the water for a mill, 945.
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WAYS,

statements of claim:

- for obstructing a private right of way, 517.
- for placing on a highway an obstruction over which the plaintiff fell, 408, 457.

defences:

- denial of plaintiff's possession of a message or land in respect of which the right of way is claimed, 946.
- denial of an alleged title by enjoyment to a right of way and averment that the user was not of right, 947.
- defence of a private right of way under the Prescription Act, 1832...947.
- a like form specifically justifying the removal of fences, and other alleged acts of trespass, 948.
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
