CURLS THAT LAST.

Method That Gives Results That

A Method That Gives Results That
Defy Climatic Conditions.
Here is one woman's secret method
of curling her hair so that it remains
fluffy and wavy in spite of any climate.
Even humidity or salt air, it is claimed,
does not affect hair so treated.
The method consists in the use of a
simple egg wash and the doing up of
the hair in a peculiar manner before
rolling it around the kid rollers.
The white of one egg is stirred slightly, but not beaten or separated in any
way. This liquid is then diluted with
a little water, preferably rose water, al-

way. Amis liquid is then diluted with a little water, preferably rose water, although soft water of any sort may be used, with a few drops of any favorite perfume, to give the hair a delicate odor. One-third as much water as odor. One-third as much water as white of an egg are the proportions given, and this should be kept in a small, wide mouthed jar upon ice, if possible, where it will keep for a week or until it is all used. When not in use the kid rollers should be kept in a sachet, rath-

rollers should be kept in a sachet, rather strongly scented.

At night the hair that is to be waved is parted from the back hair and the latter rolled up out of the way. Moisten a comb repeatedly and draw it through the hair to be curled until it is thoroughly damp, then divide the hair into strands, and before winding each strand around the curler twist if round and round tightly, then rell it round and round the curler. It is the first twisting before wrapping it around the curler that makes the peculiar fluffiness that is so much desired. The wrapping it around the kild roller makes it wave, and the egg wash causes it to retain the fluffiness.


