- T the Provincial Parliament, begun and holden at Quebec, the seventeenth day of December, Anno Domini one thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, in
- the thirty-third Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by
- ' the Grace of GOD, of Great-Britain, France and Ireland KING, Defender of the faith, &c.
- ' And from thence continued by several Prorogations to the twentieth day of November, one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, being the fourth Session of the first Provincial Parliament of Lower-CANADA.

C A P. I.

An Act to declare and afcertain the Period when the Acts of the Provincial Parliament of this Province shall take effect.

Preamble.

THEREAS it is expedient that the period from which the Laws of this Province are to have operation and effect, should be precisely asertained, be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, conflicuted and Assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled " An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act paffed " in the fourteenth year of His Majelly's Reign" inituled " An Act for making more effectival
