vince, and to have their advice in Provincial Parliament, do hereby make known our Royal Will and Pleasure to call a new Provincial Parliament; and do hereby further declare, that with the advice of our Executive Council, we have this day given Orders for iffuing our Writs in due form, for calling a new Provincial Parliament in our faid Province, which Writs are to bear Teste on Thursday the fifth day of this prefent month of October, and to be returnable on THURS-DAY the TWENTY-THIRD day of NOVEMBER next, for every place except the County of Gaspé, and for the County of Gaspé on the Twelfth day of January next.—In Testimony whereof these our Letters we have caused to be made Patent, and the Great Seal of our Province to be thereunto affixed; Witness our Trusty and Well Beloved SIR JAMES HENRY CRAIG, K. B. our Captain General and Governor in Chief in and over our faid Province, of Lower Canada, &c. &c. &c at our Castle of Saint Lewis, in our City of Quebec, in our faid Province, the Second day of October in the Year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nine, and in the Forty-ninth year of our Reign.
