



## Proclamation

*By His Excellency Sir THOMAS JOHN COCHRANE, Knight,*  
(L. S.) *Governor and Commander-in-Chief in and over the*  
THOS. COCHRANE. *Island of Newfoundland and its Dependencies, &c.*

**W**HEREAS the GENERAL ASSEMBLY of this Island stands prorogued until *Wednesday* the 1st day of *October* next : *And whereas* emergent business renders it necessary and expedient that the said General Assembly should meet at an earlier period.

I do therefore by these presents summon and call the said General Assembly to meet and Assemble *for the despatch of business*, on **TUESDAY** the 26th day of this Instant Month of *August*, of which all persons concerned, are required to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.

Government House, at St. John's,  
in the aforesaid Island, the 11th  
day of August, 1834, in the fifth  
year of His Majesty's Reign.
