✠ B ✠ *Assembly, that an Act made in the Eight Year of his present*
✠✠✠✠ *Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for Granting to His*
Majesty a Duty on Wheel Carriages within the Peninsula
of Halifax, and also An Act made in the fifteenth Year of his said
Majesty's Reign, in Amendment of the said Act, shall be, and the
same are hereby continued in force from the Expiration thereof
until the Thirty first Day of December One Thousand Seven Hun-
dred and Eighty.

An A C T for continuing an Act made in the 15th Year of his present Majesty's Reign, intituled an Act to empower the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, or Commander in Chief for the Time being, to prohibit the Exportation of Gunpowder, arms and Ammunition, or Salt-petre, or carrying the same Coastways.
