SENATOR GILLMOR DEAD.

The Hon. Daniel Gillmor, a member of the Dominion Senate, died suddenly a week ago at his home in Montreal. He was 63 years of age. He was a Liberal in politics and in 1904 unsuccessfully contested Charlotte County N. B., for the House of Commons. He was summoned to the Senate as a New Brunswick representative, on July 15, 1907.
