This is at last to be accomplished and on Sunday morning next a beautiful window by Ballantyne, is to be unveiled to the memory of Dr. Robertson and the Children of the Children's Hour.

The unveiling will be performed by Rev. Robert Johnson, M.A. of New Glasgow, the present pastor of Dr. Robertson's old church there and the moderator of the Maritime Synod.

St. Patrick's Church

Solemn Requiem Mass was celebrated yesterday morning for the repose of the soul of Sister Mary Josephine Griffen who passed to her reward on Tuesday, closing a religious life of sixty-one years. Leaving Watford, Ireland when only 18 years of age, she came out to Fairland and since then had many transfers, being stationed at Torbay, St. Mary's, and at St. Patrick's Convent the last 17 years. The celebrant of the Mass was Rev. Fr. Sheehan with the Rev. Fr. Sullivan as Deacon, Rev. Fr. Summers as Sub-Deacon, and as Master of Ceremonies, Rev. Fr. St. John, who also conducted the singing of the boys' choir. The last blessing was imparted by Mr. Rev. Mons. Kitchin. In the sanctuary were Revs. Fr. McCarthy, Pippy, Dr. Carter, Savin, P. J. Kennedy, and McGettigan. The burial took place immediately after Mass, and after a life spent in the service of the Master, the devoted religious now rests in the quiet cemetery near her convent.
