**MEN, NOT VOTES, IS
GAYNOR'S SUFFRAGE
SOLUTION**

Million and Half Are Single in
England; They Cause
Trouble, Says Mayor

New York, May 23.—"As soon as
a majority of the women want to vote,
they will get it, but as soon as every
woman has a man, the women get to
be very peaceful," said Mayor Gaynor,
in an interview discussing the question
of "votes for women."
"I do not think the women in this
country will ever resort to the violence
of the English suffragettes," said
the mayor. "There is a deep reason
for that. Over in Great Britain there
are about a million and half women
who have no man. We have no such
condition over here."
As soon as every woman has a man
the women get to be very peaceful. But
just think of a million and half women
without a man. I do not blame
them for getting mad. They ought to
tear down all England. The men got
up and went off to Australia and Can-
ada and Van Dieman's land, and Lord
knows where else, and left the women
there. And now we are having the
result.

"The women are going to burn the
whole place down unless they are al-
lowed to vote. But will it do them any
good if they are allowed to vote? Val-
uing their men, are their husbands.
They will be as 'had off' in that re-
spect as ever. Over here there is no
such numerical disparity between men
and women. I suppose most of our
women suffragettes are married."
