AUTO ACCIDENT ON LONDON HIGHWAY PROVES FATAL

John Berdan, of Warwick, is Dead; James Gavigan Has Two Broken Ribs.

Both Men Were Pinned Under Wreckage Eight Miles From Sarnia

John Berdan, 47, of Warwick village is dead and James Gavigan also of Warwick, is in the Sarnia general hospital with two broken ribs as the result of an automobile accident on the Sarnia-London highway, eight miles east of Sarnia on Saturday evening. The car, which was driven by Berdan turned over twice on the road, the two men being pinned beneath it. Dr. T. P. Bradley has decided that no inquest is necessary.

The two men were returning to Warwick from the city early in the evening. They were proceeding at from 25 to 35 miles an hour and sought to turn out of a gravel rut. Apparently the car could not hold its momentum with the turn of the wheel and turned over twice.

Skull Fractured

Berdan was rendered unconscious and two men were brought to the Sarnia general hospital, being admitted about 8 o'clock. Berdan died on Sunday morning from fracture of the skull and Gavigan is reported to be resting comfortably.

Berdan was a married man and his widow survives. The funeral was held from his late residence, London road, Tuesday, and was largely attended. The services were conducted by Rev. A. Roy Johnston, of the Methodist church, Warwick village. The two brothers of the deceased, Colin, of Blackwell, and Gibb, of Petrolia, attended the funeral, as did also two of the sisters, Mrs. Merceia Mars, of Southwold, and Mrs. Robt. Has a race record of 2.05 3/4, trial of 2.03, half in 58 1/2 seconds. A free legged pacer, wears nothing but his harness, and a horse that Mr. E. T. Gurs gave his record and regarded him as being perfect in gait, had a world of speed, and was game, what more could a great man say about a horse.
