Faith is a divine principle wrought in the heatit.

Faith comes by special spiritual influences, either previous to, or accompanying the word, &c. &c.

The Spirit is given to an unbeliever, before, he believes and obeys the Gospel; unlo failh.

"It is by the influence of the Holy Spirit ALONE, that men are regenerated and turned unto God."

"Unless the heart is first changed by some higher influence the truth of itself cannot produce love to God."

"This doctrine effectually excludes boasting."

"Whom the world cannot receive." "The Holy Ghost, whom God hath given to them that OBEY him."

"Repent and be baptized every one of you," "and ye SHALL receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

"AFTER THAT YE BELIEVED ye were sealed with that Holy Spirit of promise."

"That we might receive the promise of the Spirit, THROUGH FAITH."

"Of his own will begat he us with the word of truth."

"Being born again, not of corruptible seed, but of incorruptible BY THE WORD OF GOD, which liveth and abideth forever." "And this is the word which by the Gospel is preached unte you."

"I am not ashamed of the Gospel of Christ, FOR IT IS THE POWER OF GOD unto salvation, to every one that believeth."

"Where is boasting then? It is excluded, By what law? of works? nay; BUT BY THE LAW OF FAITH."

"The law of the Lord is perfect, CONVERTING THE SOUL: The testimony of the Lord is sure, MAKING WISE the SIMPLE, The statutes of the Lord arc
