powers, and privileges, as herein provided.

## VOTES OF MEYBEES

23. Every memher shall have one rote and no more. No member shall be entitled to vote ai any meeting unless all moneys which, at the time of such meeting, shall have been due from him to the Assosiation for more than one year shall have been paid.

## YOTICES.

24. A notice may be served by the Association upon any member, either personally or by seuding it through the mail in a letter addressed to such member at his registered place of abode.
25. Any nntice, if served by mail, shall be deemed to have been served at the time when the letter would be delivered in the ordinary course of the mail, and, in proving such service, it shall he sufficient to prove that the letter was properly addressed and put into the post office.

## BY.LAWS

## OF TIEE

MANITOBA MEDICAL ASSOCLATION. Pasved wind day of May, 1590.

## ELECTION OF MEMBERS.

1. Any qualified medical practitioner not disqualified by any by-law of the Associntion who shall be recommended as eligible by any member may (sabject as hereinafter meationed) be elected a member of the Association.
2. No person shall be elected a member unless he has a majority of the votes of the members present at the meeting of the Association at whici he is proposed for election, and has agreed in writing to become a member, and to pay his subscription for the current year.
3. Any member may be expelled from the Association by a resolution of the

Association if carried by threefourths of the members present at an annual general meeting, and he shall thereupori case to be a member. One month's notice of the intention to propose such resolution shall be given to any member affected thereby.

## SUESCRIPTION.

4. The subscription to the Association shall be two dollars per annzm, which shall entitle each member to the privilages of membership. The subscription shall date, and be considered due in adrance, on the lst day of January in each year.
5. Any member whose subscription shall not have been paid on or before the 31st December of the cuirent year shail be suspended from all privileges of membership; and, at the end of the succeeding year, if the arrears be still unpaid, he shall cease to be a member, and shall be ineligible for readmia ion until he shall have paid all arrears due at the period of his suspension. Any member wishing to withdraw from the Association shall give written notice of his intention to the Secretary-Treasurer on or before the lst December of the current year.

## HONORARY MEMBERS.

6. Any medical man of professional eminence and recommended by two members, may be elected an honorary member at the annual meeting of the Association.

## ANNUAL MEETLAG

7. The date of the annual meeting shall be fixed and the place of meeting determined prospectively in each year by the rote of the Association.

## OFFICERS.

8. The President of the Association shall be elected annually, at the annual meeting, and shall enter upon the duties of his office at the next annual meeting, and until then shall bear the title of Presidentelect. The President and Presidentelect shall be ex officio members of all committees and sub committees of the Association.
