Doors open at 7 o'clock; chair will be taken at 7.45 precisely.

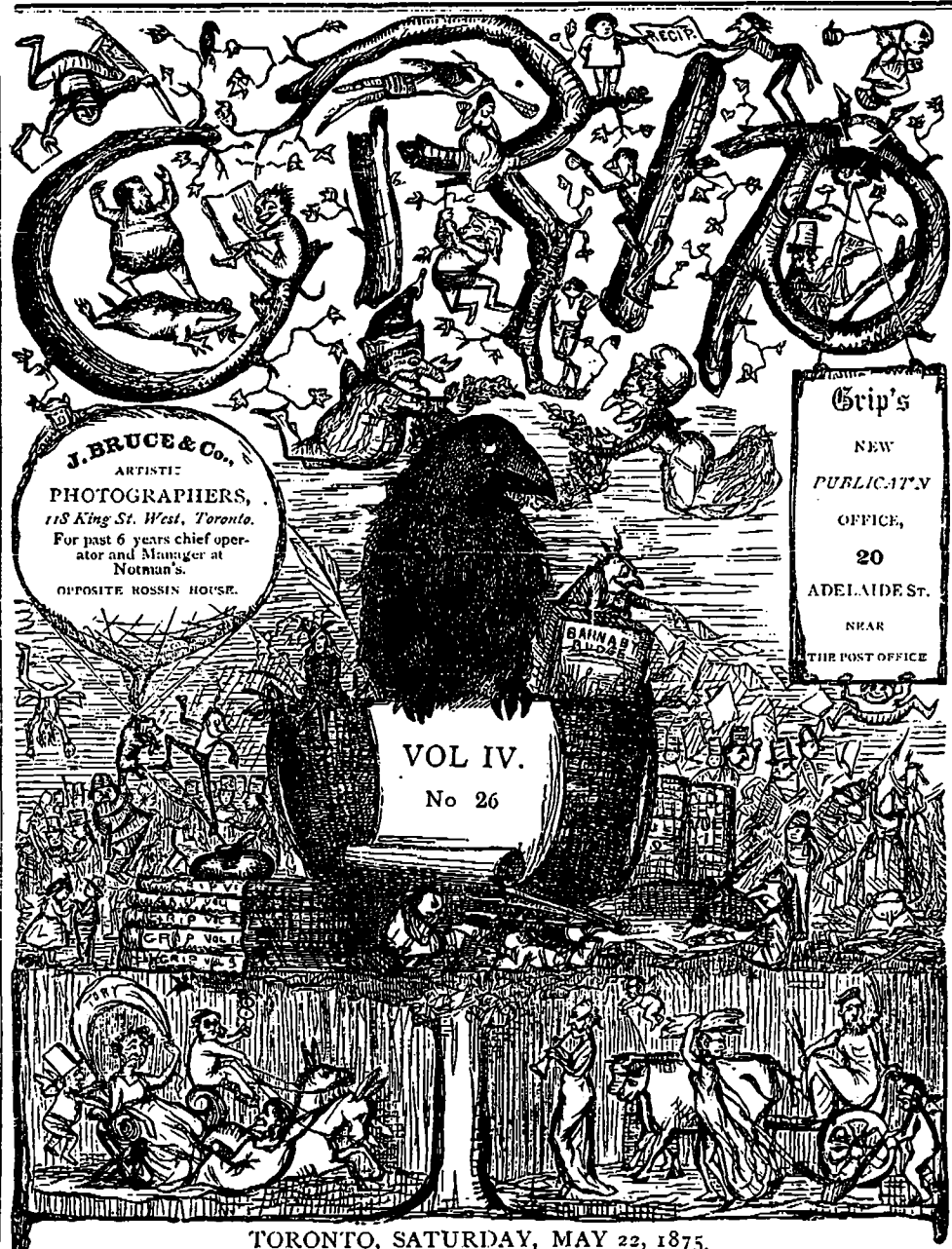
