null and void any declarations or reservations made by any Govern-ments in connection with the Final Act of the United Nations Sugar Conference signed in London on August 24, 1953 or the present Agree-ment, which are incompatible with or derogatory to the legitimate position of the Government of the Republic of China. It is further recalled that during the Conference the Chinese Delegation, when supporting the Cuban reservation that the balance of the Cuban 1953 sale to the United Kingdom should not be charged against her 1954 quota, did also declare that the balance of shipment contracted by the Republic of China with Japan for 1953 should be similarly treated. The balance is now estimated at 50,000 metric tons not to be charged against the 1954 quota of the Republic of China. It is with this reservation that the Chinese Delegation signs the present Agreement.
