

exclusive use. Missions shall apply to an oil company for a credit card issued in the name of each of their members entitled to the above-mentioned privilege. When monthly statements of account are submitted the company will deduct therefrom the amount of the tax.

(iv) In Quebec, sales tax has to be paid at the time of purchase. It is subsequently reimbursed on presentation of sales slips marked "paid", to the Protocol Service, Department of Intergovernmental Affairs, Building G, 1225 George V, Quebec City, G1A 0A6.

(v) In other provinces, application for reimbursement should be addressed to the provincial Department of Revenue.

(b) Driver's Licence

(i) Ontario driver's licence

Driver's licences and licence renewals are issued without charge to foreign representatives included in the Diplomatic and Consular List, and their spouses who are in possession of a valid foreign driver's permit. However, all first-time applicants for an Ontario drivers licence must pass the standard eye examination.

Procedure

Applications for the issuance or renewal of licences must be submitted to Protocol Division together with an exact copy of the foreign driver's permit still in force, with certified translation if not in English or French. Upon receipt of these documents, Protocol will recommend to the Ontario Ministry of Transport and Communications the issuance of a driver's licence free of cost. International Driver's licences are not accepted for this purpose.

Persons who do not as yet hold a valid licence must undergo a driving test and pay the cost thereof. Spouses and dependent children of diplomatic consular officers are also eligible for complimentary driving licences.

(ii) Quebec driver's licences

Driver's licences are issued without examination to diplomatic and consular representatives and their spouses who are in possession of a valid foreign driver's permit. However, charges are levied. These provide for the payment in part of the compulsory automobile insurance recently established in Quebec. This being mentioned in the automobile insurance law, no exceptions are made. Consequently, requests should be directed to the nearest Motor Vehicle Bureau, Provincial Department of Transport.
