The productivity rate is defined as the number of travel documents issued per person– year. There are two variations of the rate: the first takes into account overhead; and the second includes operations personnel only.

The productivity rate is influenced by the seasonal fluctuations in demand for passports. As most travel occurs in the last quarter of the fiscal year, more staff are required at that time to process applications.

In the 1994–95 fiscal year, the overall productivity rate of the Passport Office was 2,681, a slight increase over the previous year and a 7 per cent increase compared to the 1994–95 Business Plan forecast. The productivity rate of operations personnel (overhead excluded) reached 3,614 travel documents per person– year, remaining constant at the 1993–94 level. In 1994–95, revenue reached \$49.6 million, an increase of \$3.1 million (6.7 per cent) over the previous year.

Revenues

In 1994–95, revenue reached \$49.6 million, an increase of \$3.1 million (6.7 per cent) over the previous year. The increased revenue was due to a 5.9 per cent increase in volume.
