It was moved by Mr. J. K. Smith, seconded by Principal McKnight, and agreed to. that the consideration of the matter of the distribution of the Common Fund for the support of the Montreal, Kingston, and Toronto Colleges be intrusted to a Committee representing the whole Church, with instructions to report to next General Assembly.

The Moderator requested Mr. Smith to furnish a list of members to compose the Committee now agreed upon.

PRINCE ALBERT MEMORIAL.

Mr. D. M. Gordon submitted a memorial and petition from the Presbyterian Congregation of Prince Albert, transmitted by the Presbytery of Manitoba, praying the Assembly to institute a High School at Prince Albert, for the instruction of the youth of both sexes.

On motion of Dr. Moore, it was agreed to receive the memorial of the people of the town of Prince Albert, and remit it to the Foreign Mission Committee, with instructions to report at an early Sederunt.

COMMITTEE ON UNIFICATION OF FOREIGN MISSION WORK.

The Moderator then appointed the Committee on the Unification of Foreign Mission work, agreed upon at a former Sederunt, to be composed of the members of the Foreign Mission Committee-Eastern and Western Sections-as found in a printed list of said Committee now in the hands of members of Assembly. On motion of Dr. J. B. Fraser, Dr. MacLaren, the Moderator, was appointed Convener of the Committee on Unification.

The Committee were instructed to meet prior to the rising of this Assembly.

The hour of adjournment having arrived, the Assembly adjourned, to meet again at half-past two o'clock, of which public intimation was made, and this Sederunt was closed with the Benediction.

SIXTEENTH SEDERUNT.

On the same day, and at the same place, at half-past two o'clock in the afternoon:

The Assembly met, and was constituted with devotional exercises, praye sing offered, at the Moderator's request, by Mr. Peter Wright, of Stratford.

The Minutes of the last Sederunt were read and sustained.
