He will keep a regular account of the Battalion funds, submitting the same for examination and audit at the Annual Meeting of the Officers. To assist him in the collection of dues and other matters connected with his department, he will command the assistance of the Paymaster-Sergeant, who is placed immediately under his orders, and will afford him such aid as he may require.

- 9. The Surgeon.—This Officer, or the Assistant-Surgeon must be present at all Parades, when firing with blank ammunition takes place; also when any Company turns out for Ball practice, on due notice thereof. The Assistant-Surgeon is placed solely under his orders, and will render him all the assistance he may require for the due performance of his duties. The Hospital Sergeant is also placed immediately under his orders, and will obey such instructions as he may receive from himself or the Assistant-Surgeon.
- 10. THE QUARTERMASTER.—This Officer will take charge of all stores, or other public
