

STANDING ORDERS

OF THE

Civil Service Rifle

REGIMENT.

*(As adopted at a meeting of the Officers, held at Ottawa, on the
26th October, 1866.)*

1. The Badge and Device of the Regiment, to be worn on the appointments of Officers, non Commissioned Officers and men, will be :—

The Union Jack, surrounded by the Garter with maple leaf in the centre and the words "Civil Service Rifle Regiment" on the Garter, to be surmounted by the Crown. The Ornaments for Officers to be in Bronze, the Breast-plate letters and tendrils of leaf, only, to be burnished. For non Commissioned Officers, Ornaments to be all Bronze.
