PURITANICAL FOSSILS CITY ALDERMEN DUBBED

Temperance People to Begin Campaign for Reduction—Death of Rabbi Weiss.

HAMILTON, July 30.—(Special.)—When W. F. Miller was summoned to police court this morning on the charge of allowing his dog to run on the street contrary to a city bylaw he denounced the aldermen as "puritanical old fossils." John Crowder, an "Indian," who is supposed to say where he got his liquor, was sent down for three weeks. Emanuel Goldberg, was committed for trial on the charge of obtaining scrap iron by fraud.

Campaign For Reduction. The temperance people will meet next Thursday evening to make arrangements for a four months' campaign for license reduction. Some of them would like to have the number cut from 65 to 30. But it is likely they will agree on a smaller reduction. They will appoint an organizer for the campaign, who will commence his duties on Sept. 1. Their candidates for board of control will be Aldermen Morris, Peregrine, and Lees and ex-Ald. Bailey.

Rabbi Weiss Dead. Rabbi Louis Weiss, who died in the Glasgow Hospital to-day from an overdose of a sedative, was stationed at the Hughson-street Synagogue here about two years ago. Hugh Spittal, Glanford township, has begun a suit against William Roy Thompson for the alleged betrayal of his daughter.
